If you missed the Festival, you can still enjoy individual performances, for they are now available on YouTube through the Festival link below. Enjoy!

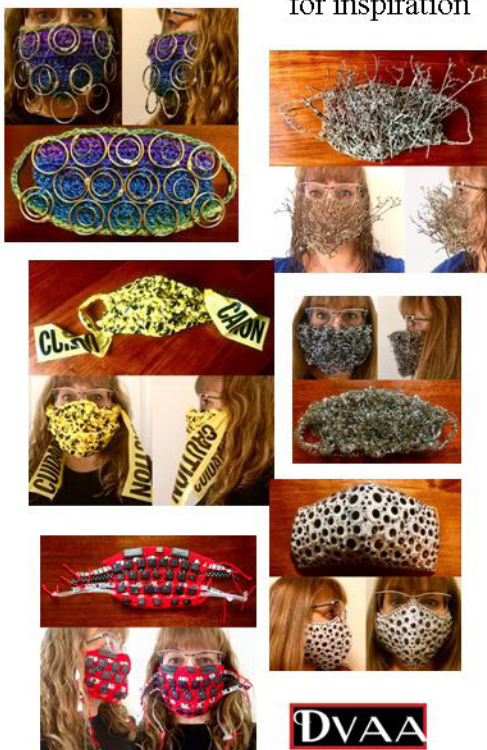
